

RECOMMENDATIONS :

Please

It is strictly forbidden to drive trolley and buggy on the front green and green color. It is also not allowed to drive trolley and buggy between the green and bunkers. Replace divots - Repair ball-marks on greens - Rake and smooth footprints in bunkers. Leave rakes in bunkers - Do not pass between bunkers and green with your trolley. In the interest of all, players should play with a good pace and without delay.

LOCAL RULES:

1. Out of bounds (rule 27): Out of bounds are defined by white stakes or fences. Furthermore, all roads and paths delimiting the course, the parking and the club-house are out-of-bounds. A ball which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

2. Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESA) :

The high rough zones located on holes 7 to 11 and delimited with bottom blue and top green stakes are Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESA). It is strictly forbidden to enter these areas, if it is known or virtually certain that a ball has come to rest in such an area, the ball is considered to be lost in a Ground Under Repair (GUR) area as per rule 25-1c. The player must substitute another ball and take relief either :

- as prescribed in rule 25-1b(i), without penalty, if the ball last crossed the outermost limit of the ESA at a spot through the Green
- as prescribed in Rule 26.1 (Relief for Ball in Water Hazard), with one penalty shot, if the ball crossed the outermost limit of the ESA at a spot in a Water Hazard on holes 9 and 10.

3. Ground under repair :

All areas marked by blue stakes; relief must be taken under R25 - 1.b All areas marked by white lines. Play optional; relief may be taken under R25 - 1.b

4. Obstructions :

Staked trees: If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in R24 - 2.b (i). All paths on the course are immovable obstructions, whether or not artificially surfaced.

5. Stones in bunkers :

Stones in Bunkers are movable obstructions

Penalty for breach of local rule 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 :

Stroke Play ; 2 strokes - Match Play ; Loss of the hole

6. When play is suspended for lightning.

Players shall discontinue play (stop) immediately and shall not thereafter resume play until the committee has ordered a resumption of play.

- two gun shots or notes or siren ; stop.

- One gunshot or short note of siren ; resume.

Penalty for breach of local rule 6 : disqualification.

7. On the right part of holes 3 and 17 :

The lateral water hazard goes to infinity

DOUBT AS PROCEDURE (R.3-3) :

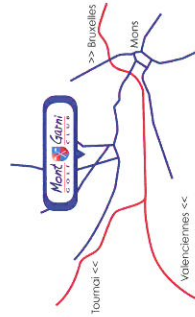
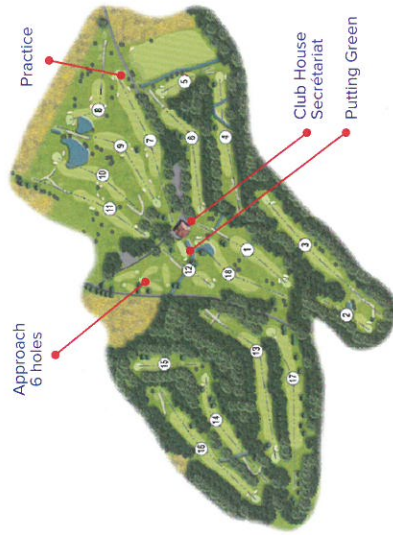
When during play of a hole a competitor is doubtful of his rights or procedure, and no referee is readily available, play of a second ball in accordance with R.3-3 (only in Stroke Play), is encouraged to avoid undue delay.

GENERAL INFORMATION :

Distance markers stakes (white) : 150m from the CENTER of the green.

Plates : respectively 200m (white - only on Par 3), 150m (yellow), 100m (red), 50m (blue) from the ENTRANCE of the green.

Scorecards shall be checked and signed at the recording office in the clubhouse immediately after completion of the round (see R.6 - 6. b). See on the exteriorly board if any other temporary local rule is in operation.
